Steel is an alloy of iron and carbon containing less than 2% carbon and 1% manganese and small amounts of silicon, phosphorus, sulphur and oxygen. Steel is the world's most important engineering and construction material. Because of it high tensile strength and low cost. steel is used in buildings, infrastructure, tools, ships, trains, cars, machines, electrical appliances, and weapons. Iron is the base metal of steel. It is used in every aspect of our lives; in cars and construction products, refrigerators and washing machines, cargo ships and surgical scalpels.

Steel is a fundamental to achieving a circular economy. It ensures optimum utilization of resources through recovery and reuse, remanufacturing and recycling. Steel is inextricably linked with economic growth and prosperity. It has enabled our modern way of life. It has spurred economic growth, lifting millions of people out of poverty and continuous to do so around the world today. For society, the benefits include durable products, local jobs, reduced emissions and conservation of raw material.

Global crude steel production has increased to 1864 Million Ton in 2020 which has grown by 30% in last 10 years and 22% in last 20 years. China is the largest crude steel producer in the world having 56.5% share of total steel production which is 1053 Million Ton followed by India, Japan and Russia with 99.6 Million Ton, 83.2 Million Ton and 73.4 Million Ton Respectively.



Steel is basic ingredient of growth and we can see opportunity lies in our country by analyzing the per capita steel consumption. The table below taken from WSA, 2019 may depict the scenario quite easily.

Hence, the Government of India has taken ambitious plan to produce 300 million ton of crude steel by year 2030 which will increase per capital steel consumption from 74 kg to 160 kg. National steel policy in 2017 has helped the industry in India to reach global market. Implementation of steel scrap recycling policy has helped reduction in import of the steel and it shall be further improved by roll out of **Atmanirbhar Bharat initiative**. This demand shall be supported by growth in domestic market itself with government's investment in infrastructure, energy, defence and growth in automotive industry. Even the budget 2021 has lots of schemes to support the steel industry.





